REGISTRATION FEES

Registration begins on March 1 and ends on May 31. During early registration, the price of each session is \$900 for K-5 campers.

From June 1 on the price of each session is \$1,000 for K-5 campers.

Please note there is no combining of weeks

from different sessions or registering for partial sessions.

The Extended Day program will run this summer for \$450 per session.
